These Terms and Conditions apply to each Attendee regardless of whether they formally registered. **Indemnity.** The Attendee agrees to protect, indemnify, defend, and hold harmless CDM, the Conference hotel(s) and their respective employees, officers, directors, and agents against all claims, losses, or damages to persons or property, governmental charges or fines, and costs (including reasonable attorney's fees) arising out of or connected to the actions or failure of the Attendee or its employees, officers, directors, and agents to act in accordance with these Terms and Conditions. **Registration Badge.** The Attendee's registration badge must be worn at all times during the CDM.
